Procedure where the number of applicants exceed the number of places available:

If the number of applicants is greater than the number of places available offers to enrol will be made using the criteria below in the order given and unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a waiting list:

5.Oversubscription

In the event that the school is oversubscribed, the school will, when deciding on applications for admission, apply the following selection criteria in the order listed below to those applications that are received within the timeline for receipt of applications as set out in the school's annual admission notice:

1. Applicants who have a brother who is currently attending the school.
2. Applicants who have a brother who was a student in the school within the previous 10 years.
3. Applicants whose parent/guardian is a staff member of the school.
4. Applicants who attend Belgrove BNS, Scoil Assaim BNS, St. Brigid's BNS and Holy Trinity BNS provided that the number of available places, rounded to the nearest whole number, for each school shall be the same proportion of pupils attending first year from each school in the previous year.
5. Applicants from a category 4 school who are not selected under category 4.
6. Applicants whose father attended the school¹.
7. All other applicants.

Any applicant who has also applied to another school shall automatically be placed in category 7.

In the event that there are a number of students tied for a place or places in any of the selection criteria categories above (the number of applicants exceeds the number of remaining places), a lottery shall apply.

Note: (i) When a criterion has been reached for which there are insufficient places available, a random draw will take place of all applicants who satisfy that particular criterion and they will then be listed in the order in which they are drawn.

¹ Places offered in accordance with this criterion cannot exceed 25% of the available places as set out in the school's annual admission notice.
