



Statement in response to the publication of the Scoping Inquiry Report

The Board of Management of St Paul's College welcomes the publication of the Scoping Inquiry Report into historical allegations of abuse in schools run by religious orders.

The report identified 11 allegations of abuse against 3 alleged abusers. The 3 alleged abusers are now deceased.

The Board of Management welcomes the recent statement from the Vincentian Community offering support to anyone harmed during their time in St. Pauls. A copy of that statement is available on the College website.

We would encourage any person who was harmed during their time in our school to come forward. We are committed to helping in any way we can.

The College will fully cooperate with the recently announced Commission of Investigation.

Whilst the Scoping Inquiry Report and the Commission of Investigation relate to historical allegations of abuse, the College complies with all current obligations in relation to child welfare. Our safeguarding policy and associated documentation are available on our website.

If any person has any concerns in relation to any child safety matter they should contact the College, the Gardai or Tusla immediately.
